The scholarship winner will be notified no later than **June 1**. The CJWC treasurer will send the award to the school after receiving the Acceptance Form signed by the winner and the school registrar.

Each Applicant must complete the application as follows:

- 2. Attach Two (2) letters of reference to the application one from an individual in the community and one from an individual in the school.
- 3. Attach a letter from attending school verifying student's GPA (grade point average).
